Dear Friends,

“But let all those that put their trust in Thee rejoice: let them ever shout for joy, because Thou defendest them: let them also that love Thy name be joyful in Thee. ¹² For Thou, Lord, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt Thou compass him as with a shield.” Psalm 5:11-12

The above bible passage was the theme verse for this year’s ALCA Church Convention held last month in Esko, Minnesota. It is indeed a fitting verse for the yearly gathering of our brothers and sisters in Christ Jesus. The meals were delicious, the music was uplifting and the fellowship was wonderful. The Esko congregation put forth a fine effort and did not disappoint. There was indeed a joyful spirit at this year’s convention.

As always, the source of our joy is God, Himself. The most important element of our gathering is the hearing of God’s Word. The proclamation of the Gospel is not only the means by which God grants faith unto us, but also the cause for our rejoicing. As the Psalmist writes, He defends us and compasses or surrounds us with His favor.

During the Sunday morning service, Pastor Nathan Juntunen directed a choir, consisting of singers from all over our church federation. We sang the hymn “Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord God Almighty” by Reginald Heber. In the hymn, we sing about a God who is like no other. We sing of His greatness, but also of His mystery. We sing of God’s holiness, but also of His great love for sinners. In the first and fourth verse, we sing that God is both *“merciful and mighty”*. The same God by whose might created the heavens and the earth, also created you and me. The same God whose holiness demands perfection from His children, demonstrates His mercy by meeting those very demands in His Son, Jesus Christ. Indeed, we have joy, because of the One ***“...who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.”***
Hebrews 12:2

We as Christians have the greatest reason to rejoice. We have been created by God, redeemed by the blood of His Son and graced with the continual presence of His Holy Spirit. These truths are what make our joy so great and our fellowship so sweet. May God continue to make Himself known to us in the person of His Son, Jesus Christ, so that our joy might increase.
