He indeed served every one and extended himself to meet the needs of others. Through the years of his faithful service at this institution he helped so many people and I know that he continued on that pathway in every way possible throughout the balance of his earthly sojourn. His influence is still strongly felt by those in the Seminary as his compassion was a marvelous witness to the person of the incarnate Christ. Patty too so powerfully influenced the life of my first wife Theresa (Deceased 2009) with her positive example and support, Theresa always sought to emulate Patty as a pastor's wife and saw her as one of her greatest blessings.

So it is that another of those witnesses has passed on into the heavenlies after gracing our lives for these many years and we bless God; all of us who had the privilege to know Wayne and enjoy his fellowship. We pray for Patty in the loss of her beloved husband that the Lord would continue to sustain her in His grace.
